# Report on Limited Review of WEBFIL LIMITED for the quarter ended 30th June, 2017.

We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited financial results of **WEBFIL LIMITED** ("the Company") for the quarter ended 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2017 ("the results"). The Statement has been prepared by the Company pursuant to Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, read with SEBI Circular No.CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated 5<sup>th</sup> July 2016 which has been initiated by us for the purpose of identification. This statement is the responsibility of the Company's Management and has been approved by the Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the Indian Accounting Standard for Interim Financial Reporting ("Ind AS 34") prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to issue a report on these financial statements based on our review.

We conducted our review in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagement (SRE) 2410, "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity" issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement. A review is limited primarily to inquiries of company personnel and analytical procedures applied to financial data and thus provides less assurance than an audit. We have not performed an audit and accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Based on our review conducted as above, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying statement of unaudited financial results prepared in accordance with applicable Indian Accounting Standards and other recognized accounting practices and policies, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 read with SEBI Circular No.CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated 5th July 2016 including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.

- 2. The Company does not have any exceptional or extraordinary item to report for the above periods.
- 3. This Statement is as per Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligation and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015.
- 4. The Statutory Auditors of the Company have carried out a Limited Review of the Financial Results for the guarter ended 30.06.2017.
- 5. In the above statement, for the 'Corresponding quarter ended in the previous year', i.e., for the quarter ended 30th June, 2016, and for the quarter ended 31st March, 2017, Ind-AS compliant financial results have been provided, but such results have not been subjected to limited review/audit, and for the previous year ended 31st March, 2017, Ind-AS compliant financial results have been provided, but such results have not been subjected to limited review/audit. However, the management has exercised necessary due diligence to ensure that the financial results provide a true and fair view of its affairs.
- 6. There is a possibility that these quarterly financial results alongwith the provisional financial statement as of and for the quarter ended 30th June, 2017 may require adjustments before constituting the final Ind AS financial statements as of and for the year ending 31st March, 2018 due to changes in financial reporting requirements arising from new or revised standards or interpretations issued by MCA or changes in the use of one or more optional exemptions from full retrospective application of certain Ind AS as permitted under Ind AS 101.
- 7. Employee benefit costs for the interim period is calculated on a year to date basis using the actuarially determined cost rate at the end of the prior year, adjusted for significant market fluctuations and for significant one-off events, such as plan amendmendts, curtailments and settlements. In absence of, significant market fluctuations and one-off events, the estimate of acturial obligations is rolled forward in the scheme based on prior assumptions and adjusted for significant changes.
